REQUIREMENTS FOR PATHWAYS FOR YOUNG ADULTS PROGRAM


Applicants MUST be:

- 18-24
- DC Residents
- Out-of-School
- Out-of-Work
- High School Diploma or GED Recipients
- Eligible to work in the US

The Pathways for Young Adults Program (PYAP) is designed to assist out-of-school and out-of-work youth ages 18-24 by merging work readiness instruction, life skills development, and occupational training with an on-the-job experience.

Participants can receive a nationally recognized certification with the Community College of the District of Columbia in:

- o Hospitality
- o Certified Nursing Assistant
- o Medical Office Administrative Program
- o A+ Certification (Basic IT)
