District of Columbia Residential Wireline Broadband Adoption Rates

The National Telecommunications and Information Administration (NTIA), a division of the U.S. Department of Commerce, through the Broadband Data Improvement Act (BDIA), has sponsored the State Broadband Initiative. This Program is designed to fund projects that gather comprehensive and accurate state-level broadband mapping data, develop state-level broadband maps, aid in the development and maintenance of a national broadband map, and fund statewide initiatives for broadband planning.

Residential wireline broadband subscriber counts were collected from the FCC “Broadband Reporting Form” (Form 477) that each provider shared voluntarily to the District of Columbia’s Office of the Chief Technology Officer (OCTO). Form 477 provides a breakdown of subscriptions by subscriber type (residential vs. commercial) and connection speed by census tract. Residential broadband subscribers were calculated for each provider and then aggregated to provide the total number of broadband subscribers by census tract. Broadband adoption rates for each census tract were calculated as the ratio of residential broadband subscribers to the total number of households/occupied housing units reported in the census. The program defines broadband as speeds of at least 768 kbps download and 200 kbps upload.

Overall, the district-wide adoption rate has increased from 57.8% in December 2008 to 76% in December 2013. However, as the following maps and tables show, the range of adoption varies widely across the district. From nearly 100% adoption in more affluent neighborhoods to adoption rates below 40%, which NTIA defines as “underserved”, in lower income rates.














